

BADGER BUSH LODGE

RULES and RECOMMENDATIONS

Adhering to these rules and recommendations will ensure you and those around you will enjoy your stay

The Lodge is a NON smoking area. Smokers to utilise the area around the built in braai. Please use the ash trays provided. No stompies to be left lying around.

Do not feed the animals*, and do not leave food items lying around as the monkeys and others become real pests if enticed in this manner. When you leave the lodge, even for a short walk, please ensure all doors and windows are shut.

Please do not set the air conditioners lower than 21 degrees and keep all doors and windows shut when in use.

Keep the net windows and doors shut at all times to keep out unwanted bugs and creatures.

Please keep the door to the rubbish cage and gas bottle enclosure, shut and bolted.

Please do not leave fires unattended, and cover the Boma fire with the plate provided when you leave at the end of the evening.

The collection of wood / kindling from surrounding areas for the fire is strictly prohibited.*

TV and music may not be played loudly*.

Please ensure all cushions and linen are brought in at night.

Please check the inventory to the list provided on arrival and before you leave, and notify us immediately of any shortfall.

A maximum of 10 people, babies included, may occupy the lodge*.

Please tip the lodge attendant, if satisfied with her service, R 50.00 per room per week. If not satisfied with the level of service please feel free to contact me during your stay.

Do not walk around bare footed or in slip slops, especially at night.

Snakes are prevalent in the area so please be aware of the area around you and your actions
